In January 2014, the NSW Government announced a package of measures including liquor licensing restrictions, one punch fatal assault laws, mandatory minimum sentencing for these and other serious assaults, and community education as part of a comprehensive package to make our streets safe

Parliament was recalled on 30 January to implement most of the [legislative](#) measures " with the provisions coming into force on 24 February 2014

The NSW Government has no intention of loosening these arrangements " we do not intend to reverse or water down the lockout laws
