Dear Lord Mayor and City of Sydney Councillors,

Re: Woolloomooloo Playground upgrade

We are a residents' action group that advocates for residents and businesses in the 2011 postcode covering Potts Point, Elizabeth Bay, Rushcutters Bay and Woolloomooloo.

We write in support of the issues raised by Woolloomooloo resident Carlyn Chen in her email to the Lord Mayor and City of Sydney Councillors dated 4 November 2022.

We are concerned that due process has not been followed in this matter, by limiting access to a thorough consultation with resident regarding the proposed changes/upgrades to the Woolloomooloo Playground area.

Some of the proposed works may well be of benefit to the area, but ideally these should be determined in consultation with the community who will be most affected by the changes, to allow them a chance to put forward their concerns regarding the design and construction elements, including proposed amenities and equipment in the upgraded playground, and including suggestions and alternative proposals.

We urge Councillors to engage with the local Woolloomooloo community and residents who we know are passionate about their neighbourhood and the well-being of their children, who will ultimately be the beneficiaries of any changes/upgrades to the area.
